With a deep-rooted passion for creating timeless pieces and an unwavering commitment to meticulous attention to detail, Cache River Mill & MetalWorks has established itself as a premier provider of high-quality custom millwork solutions in both the residential and commercial fields.

Cabinetry, trim, doors, paneling and just about anything else made of wood can all be modeled and fabricated here in our shop and installed by our qualified crews. We also have an incredible quartz/granite/solid surface partner, and a very detailed upholstery partner that allows us to place and take responsibility for multiple trades under one contract, giving you one point of contact for the project.

We also have the capacity to build casework, countertops and other custom projects out of plastic laminate, while our metal shop can add decorative elements where needed.

In the first quarter of 2023, we moved into our new 40,000+ square foot facility on East Broadway Street in North Little Rock. Here, our project managers, engineers and craftsmen work with architects, contractors, builders, designers and individual clients to bring concepts to life. Our shop floor hosts a variety of state-of-the-art equipment, including multiple 3-axis CNC machines, a 5-axis pod and rail CNC machine, a 5-axis CNC lathe, an edge bander and a moulder. Our investment in new machinery has allowed us to increase productivity and fabricate complex projects more efficiently.

I have compiled a few examples of some of our previous projects on the following pages. These illustrations exhibit shop drawings and renders from our engineering and architecture department, and finished products from our craftsmen and installation teams. Vent Hood Skirt - This vent hood skirt was fabricated out of a single piece of 100+ year old oak. The client wanted a specific amount of detail without losing the aged look of the wood. The oak is clear finished to preserve its natural elements.









Bombay Islands - These islands feature three-inch thick, solid black walnut countertops, working bombay doors, and intricate, custom corbels and drawer fronts. The drawers have hand-cut, variable width, full dovetail construction with top rail detailing. Some pull outs are double drawers and feature custom, solid wood inserts.













Wine Cellar - This wine cellar is built with a combination of solid black walnut and maple. The design incorporates a mixture of slots for individual bottles, wine cubes for stacking various shapes and sizes, display shelves and a wrap around countertop. The individual slots and the display shelves feature grooves so bottles can rest in a perfectly centered position within their own space. The climate controlled cellar sits behind large sheets of glass on top of a beautifully finished walnut floor and is surrounded in custom trim.





Progressive Staircase - This is a freestanding, circular mahogany staircase. Each successive tread has a slightly sharper radius than its neighbor as it winds down to a wrap-around first tread. Both handrails were ergonomically designed to fit the clients' hand and are supported by custom wood balusters. The handrails wrap around each newel post at the landing. What is not shown in the pictures but is visible in the shop drawings is how the underside of the staircase is open, exposing the treads and risers.











Fireplace Mantel - This highly detailed mantel is a combination of several different mantels that the client admired and asked us to match. This example shows the initial 3D renders that we created and edited through the design process. The mantel has a distressed finish, giving it an old world look.
